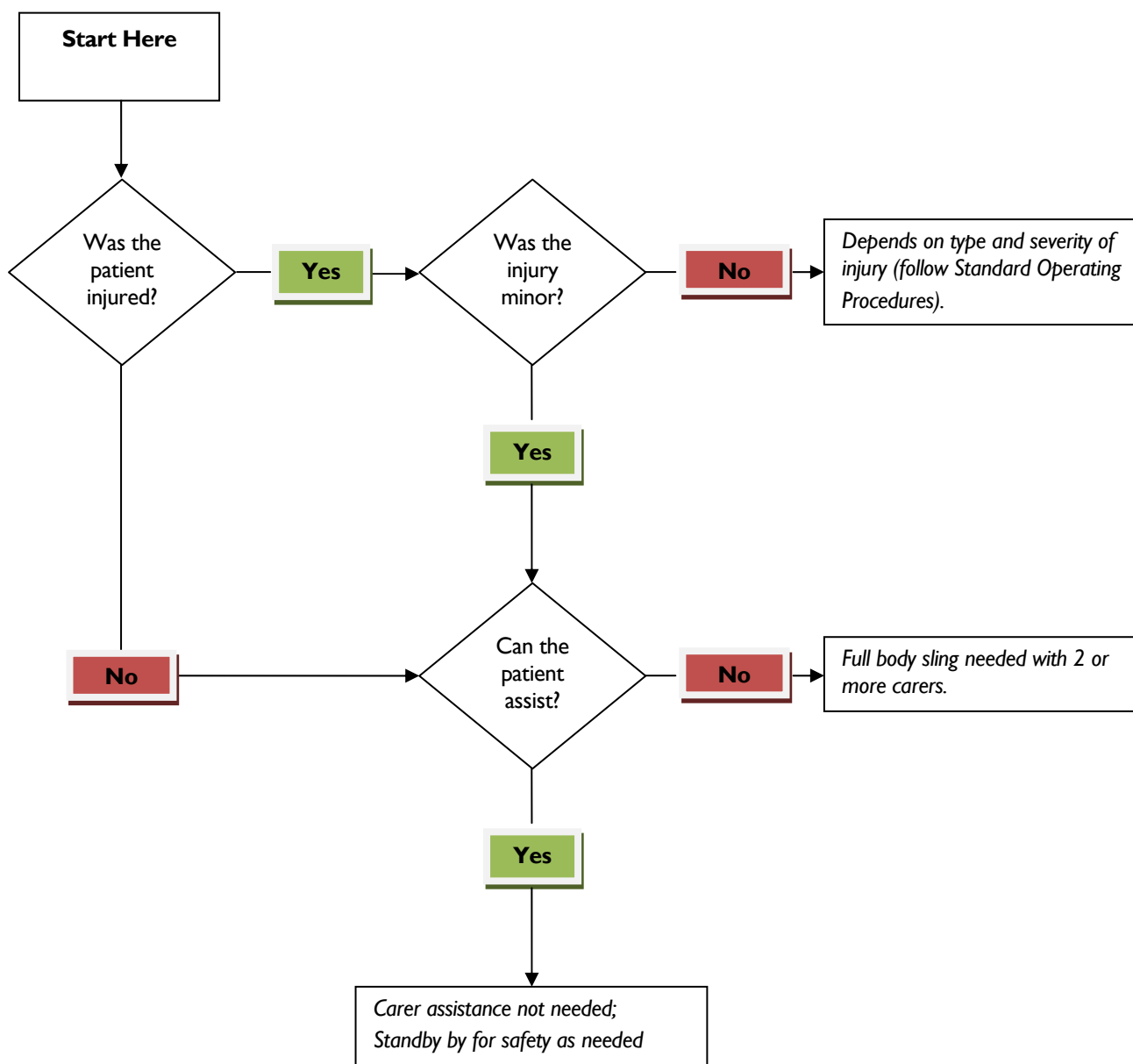


Algorithm 6: Transfer a Patient Up From the Floor

- Use full body sling hoist that goes all the way down to the floor (most of the newer models are capable of this).
- During any patient transferring task, if any caregiver is required to lift more than 35lbs/16kg. of a patient's weight, then the patient should be considered to be fully dependent and assistive devices should be used

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Note that we have used the original document but changed the terminology where appropriate, for instance adding weights in Kilograms to the originally shown Pounds.

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
